Possible new Catholic primary schools in East Anglia

This is the first opportunity to open new Catholic primary schools in East Anglia in decades. Bids have to be submitted by 1st February 2019.

Our Diocese is intending to submit bids for three new Catholic primary schools in areas of significant new housing development – one in **Northstowe** in Cambridgeshire, and **two in Peterborough at Hampton East and Great Haddon**. The Government has been very clear that only a small number of bids will be approved within this round, so we will not get all three schools. Any new schools are expected to open in September 2022 or 2023.

One of the key things the Government will look at in deciding whether to approve a bid, is how many people are interested in having more Catholic school places. Therefore we need as many people as possible to register their interest in the new schools, before the bid goes in on 1st February and the Diocese has an online form on its website where you can do this: www.rcdea.org.uk/vaschools. However, if you would prefer to fill in a paper form, there are copies for you to take at the back of Church as you leave Mass today.

This may be the only opportunity for our Diocese to get more Catholic schools, so please support us by registering your interest.
